



FAQ

Is there only one route option?

No, the participants can choose between a long loop as well as a short loop.

Is there a minimum speed to participate?

No, everyone is welcome. We do publish rankings, but the fun and the experience should be the main goal of the day.

Can the route option be changed?

Yes, in case of a change after registration, a request must be sent to info@chasingcancellara.com. Changes are only effective after official confirmation by the organizer.

Is the time taken along the entire route?

No, the time will only be taken on five defined climbs (big loop). On the small loop, the time will be taken on three climbs. The times of the climbs are accumulated to a total time for the final ranking.

How is the timing signaled?

The start and end of the timekeeping is signaled with beach flags and pillons.

Will the group wait for me on top of the climb?

Yes, at the end of the climb every rider is obliged to wait for the other members of the respective groups.

How do you ride between the climbs?

The segments between the climbs are neutralized, are ridden comfortably in the group and are not relevant for the final ranking.

What can I do if my group is too fast?

If the pace of your group is too fast, you can wait for the next group at the top of the climb and continue with them.

Will there be road closures?

No, the Granfondo Vaduz takes place in open traffic. All participants must comply with the applicable rules of the Liechtenstein and Swiss Road Traffic Act.

Will the participants be accompanied by motorcyclists?

Yes, each group will be accompanied by at least two motorcyclists.

Are there feeding zones on the route?

Yes, there is one feeding zone on the St. Luzisteig (third ascent on the big loop). Water, isotonic drinks and various foods are available there.

Are toilets available at the feeding zones?

Yes, there is a mobile toilet facility at the feeding zone.

What does the start procedure look like?

The start will take place in medium-sized groups at intervals of 10-minutes.

How will the starting groups be divided?

Participants will be divided into groups based on the average speed indicated during the registration process. There will also be different groups for the short and long loop.

When is the first start?

The start of the first participants is set to be around 10:00am. Participants' personal start times will be communicated on the Thursday before the event.

Where is the start and finish location?

The start and finish location is at the Rheinpark Stadium in Vaduz. The address is Lettstrasse 74, 9490 Vaduz, Liechtenstein.

Can I leave my luggage somewhere?

Yes, you can leave your luggage at the start number distribution point.

Where can I get my race number and timing chip?

Start numbers and the timing chip can be collected on Friday evening and Saturday morning at the start number distribution point at the start and finish area at Rheinpark Stadium Vaduz. The exact pick up times will be communicated in the road book.

How must the timing chip and race number be mounted?

The timing chip must be attached to the seat post and the start number must be placed on the back and be visible.

How does the team classification work?

Each participant completes the course individually. The times of the three fastest team members are added together to give the time for the team ranking.

What is the minimum number of members required for the team ranking?

A team must consist of at least three members. To belong to a team, the identical team name must be entered when registering. The team name can be changed or added at a later date. This requires a notification to info@chasingcancellara.com and is only effective after official confirmation.

Is there also a team ranking for the small loop?

No, the team ranking is only available for the big loop.

Where can I park?

Parking is available in a large parking lot next to the Rheinpark Stadium in Vaduz. A detailed map can be found in the road book.

Where are the showers?

Shower facilities are also available at the start and finish area at the Rheinpark Stadium in Vaduz. The path from the start/finish area to the showers is signaled

What can I expect at the finish?

After their arrival at the finish in Vaduz, the finisher will receive their well-deserved finisher medal, a goodie bag as well as a finisher meal.
