



FAQ

Is there only one route option?

No, participants have the option of completing a long route as well as a short route.

Is there a minimum speed to participate?

No, everyone is welcome. We do publish ranking lists, but the fun and experience should be the main focus.

Can the course variant be changed?

Yes, in case of a change after registration, a report must be sent to info@chasingcancellara.com.

Is the time measured on the whole course?

No, the time will be measured only on five defined climbs (big loop). On the small loop, time will be measured on three climbs. The times of the climbs are cumulated and result in the ranking.

How is the timing signaled?

The start and the end of the timing is signaled with beach flags and pillons.

Is there waiting at the top of the climb?

Yes, at the end of the climb we will wait for the whole group and then continue together.

How do you ride between the climbs?

The segments between the climbs are neutralized and are ridden comfortably in the group.

What can I do if my group is too fast?

If the pace of your group is too fast, you can wait for the next group at the top of the climb and continue with them.

Will the course be closed?

No, the Granfondo Vaduz will take place in open traffic. All participants must abide by the applicable rules of the Swiss Road Traffic Act.

Will the participants be accompanied by motorcyclists?

Yes, each group will be accompanied by two motorcyclists.

Will there be refreshment posts along the route?

Yes, there is a refreshment post on the St. Luzisteig. Water, isotonic drinks and food will be available there.

Are there toilets at the refreshment station?

Yes, at the feeding zone there is the possibility to use a mobile toilet facility.

What is the starting procedure?

The start will be in medium sized groups at 10 minute intervals.

How will the starting groups be divided?

The groups will be divided according to the average speed indicated during registration.



GRANFONDO VADUZ

When will the first start be?

The timing of the first start will take place during the morning and will be communicated at a later date.

When will the start time be communicated?

On Thursday before the event, the personal start time will be communicated to the participants.

Where will the start take place?

The start is at the town hall of Vaduz. The address is Städtle 6 in 9490 Vaduz.

Can I deposit my luggage somewhere?

Yes, your luggage can be deposited at the start number collection.

Where can I get my start number and timing chip?

The start numbers and the timing chip can be picked up on Saturday evening as well as on Sunday in the morning at the start number distribution in the start and finish area at the town hall of Vaduz. The exact collection times will be communicated in the road book.

How must the timing chip and the start number be mounted?

The timing chip must be mounted on the seat post. The start numbers must be worn on the back.

How is the team classification done?

Each participant completes the course individually. The time of the three fastest team members will be cumulated and result in the team ranking.

What is the minimum number of members required for the team ranking?

A team must consist of at least three members. To belong to a team, the identical team name must be entered during registration. The team name can be changed or added later. For this purpose, a message to info@chasingcancellara.com is necessary.

Is there also a team classification for the small loop?

No, there is only a team classification for the big loop.

Where can I park?

Parking spaces are available at the Marktplatzgarage at Giessenstrasse 7 in Vaduz. Access to the garage must be via Kirchstrasse.

Where are the showers?

Showers are available at the elementary school Äule at Giessenstrasse 11 in Vaduz. The way from the starting area to the showers is signalized and takes about 5 minutes by foot.

Where can I take my meal after the race at the finish?

Right at the start and finish area you will find the catering. With the corresponding vouchers, which will be handed out at the start number distribution, you will receive the catering.
