What is the purpose of Chasing Cancellara Flanders?

The biggest priority of the race is to experience cycling together with Fabian. Fabian won't be there to once again race in his famous region but to offer all participants a great experience. He will do the race briefing, ride in different groups, hand over the finisher medals, award the winners with prizes and be available at all times for chats and selfies.

Is a minimum speed required to be able to participate?

No. Everyone is welcome to join the event. Although we will offer rankings, having a great experience on and off the bike is the highest priority.

What does the start procedure look like?

The riders will start in blocks of 70 to 100 riders. The official start will be held on the Groot Markt in the city center of Ronse. The participants will start in different groups depending on the average speed they selected in the registration form. The exact start times of each group will be communicated within the week before the race. The participants are not required to ride in the groups during the whole race. If the tempo is too slow or too fast, the participant can continue on their own pace.

Is the whole course timed?

No. Only six climbs (Kwaremont, Paterberg, Koppenberg, Taaienbergh, Muur van Geraardsbergen and Kanarieberg) will be timed. The rest of the course will be ridden neutralized. This format offers the perfect possibility to be able to race on the famous Hellingen of Flanders but also to interact on the bike with Fabian and all the other participants.

Can I decide on the course whether to ride the short or the big lap?

People who have registered for the big lap are allowed to take a short cut to get on the short lap. People who have registered for the short lap are not allowed to ride the big lap.

Will there be a moto crew escorting the riders?

We will have a total of 20 moto riders accompanying the riders. The motocrew will be there to ride with the participants on flat sections and to help with orientation.

Will there be feeding zones on the course?

Yes. There will be three feeding zones on the big lap and one on the short one.

When will I receive the goodie bag?

The goodie bag will be handed out in the finish area close to where the finisher medals are given to the participants.

Where do I get my bib number and my time keeping chip?

Both will be handed out at the Sportscenter 't Rosco in Ronse.

Where can I park my car?

Sporthal 't Rosco in Ronse.

Where can I find shower facilities?

Sporthal 't Rosco in Ronse.
